

The sanctuary is OPEN for limited in-person worship.*

*Our in-person worship is a work-in-progress. Please be patient as we determine the rules and procedures to gather on Sunday morning while reducing the risk of spreading the CO-VID 19 virus. We understand you may make the safer choice of listening to the service from the park and parking lot, or watching the live YouTube broadcast from your home. Those who prefer to gather in the sanctuary – please follow these procedures and rules.

- Only attend if healthy and well. We will ask to scan your body temperature with a no-contact infrared thermometer.
- Wear face coverings over your mouth and nose while in the building. Anyone school-age and older are expected to wear a mask. We will have some disposable adult-size masks available in the sanctuary, if needed.
- When entering, please pick up your pre-filled communion cup at the back of the sanctuary and place your offering in the marked basket.
- Do NOT gather in the aisles and take care to not pass others in the aisles and doorways.
- Follow the directions of the ushers to sit in the cushioned rows only and sit distanced from other family groups in your row (6 feet apart). The ushers will also direct you at dismissal. If we reach maximum safe capacity, you may be directed to a viewing or listening room.
- Please respect the space of others with NO contact and hand-shaking. A nod, a wave or an elbow bump is acceptable, if the receiving bumpee is agreeable.
- Soft-spoken responses are appropriate.
